HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1277, L.D. 1784, Bill, "An Act Relating to Limited Electrician's Licenses and Funds for State Electrical Inspection."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first 2 paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1. R.S., T. 32, §1101, sub-§7, additional. Section 1101 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 7, to read as follows:

'7. Limited license. A limited electrician's license to install and service the electrical work related to a specific type of electrically operated equipment or to specific electrical installations shall be granted to any person who has passed a satisfactory examination before the board. It shall specify the name of such person who shall be limited to engage in the occupation of installing and servicing the electrical work related to the type of equipment or to specific electrical installations only authorized by this license. The annual fee for a limited electrician's license shall be \$5.'"

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 3. Limitation. Persons holding a limited electrician's license on or before September 3, 1965 shall be granted a limited electrician's license under section 1 of this Act without further examination.'
