**AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Reconstruction of Dismukes Hall,
Maine Maritime Academy.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 102nd Legislature in regular session appropriated \$265,000 for the reconstruction of Dismukes Hall, Maine Maritime Academy; and

Whereas, supplementary funds are vitally necessary to complete the project; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine Maritime Academy; appropriation for. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$75,000 to the Maine Maritime Academy for completion of the reconstruction of Dismukes Hall. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
