HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1288,  
L. D. 1793, Bill, "An Act Establishing the Maine Insurance  
Advisory Board and Reserve Fund for Uninsured Losses."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after the first paragraph  
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and Resolves of the  
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjourn-  
ment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, insurance on state-owned buildings is important  
to the people of Maine; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary  
to provide the people of Maine with sound practices in order to  
prevent any unnecessary losses on state-owned property; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of section  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the  
General Fund to the Maine Insurance Advisory Board the sum of  
\$32,700 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown of  
expenditures shall be as follows:

Further amend said Amendment by inserting at the end thereof  
the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the  
preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
