HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE JOINT ORDER, S.P. 525.

Amend said Order by striking out all of the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'ORDERED, that the Committee further study the desirability that every bill entered into the Legislature shall bear the name of the sponsor, if such sponsor is not a member of the Legislature; and be it further

ORDERED, that the Committee report the results of its study to a special session of the 102nd Legislature or to the 103rd Legislature.'
