STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Firearms in Commission of Certain Crimes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, c. 54, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter 54, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 54 FIREARMS

§ 1461. Firearms in commission of certain crimes

Whoever, during the commission of any robbery, assault, murder, rape, burglary, kidnapping or homicide, other than involuntary manslaughter, uses or carries any firearm shall be punished by imprisonment for 25 years.
