STATE OF MAINE SENATE 103rd LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 3, L. D. 6, Bill, "An Act Establishing Two Zones for Open Season on Deer."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 7th paragraph (same in L. D. 6) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Southern Zone: From the last Monday in October to the first Saturday in November following Thanksgiving.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the first sentence of the last paragraph (same in L.D. 6) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'There shall be an annual open season during-the-month-of-October from October 1st to the Saturday immediately preceding the last Monday of October in the Southeastern-and-Southwestern-Zones Southern Zone as described in section 2353 for the purpose of hunting deer with bow and arrow only, except that on the Island of Islesboro in Waldo County there shall be an open season for hunting deer with bow and arrow during the months of October and November of each calendar year.'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the llth and 12th lines (9th line in L. D. 6) the words "during the month of October" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'during-the-month-of-October from October 1st to the Saturday immediately preceding the last Monday in October'
