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**AN ACT Providing for Life Preservers for All Motorboats Operating on  
Inland Waters.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 38, § 238, sub-§ 1, ¶¶ B, C, additional.** Subsection 1 of section 238 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding 2 new paragraphs B and C, to read as follows:

**B. All other motorboats, not requiring numbering and in operation, shall carry at least one U. S. Coast Guard approved life saving device labelled as such for each person aboard. Said devices shall be maintained in good and serviceable condition and be readily accessible at all times.**

**C. The owner or operator, either one or both, shall be responsible to see that watercraft are equipped as specified in this section before operating or giving permission to operate said watercraft on the inland waters of this State.**
