HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 6, L.D. 12,
Bill, "An Act Prohibiting the Hunting of Muskrat, Mink,
Otter and Fisher with Firearms or Bow and Arrow."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last
4 lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

" '1-A. Mink. Whoever violates section 2362 shall be
punished by a fine of not less than \$50 and costs and \$50
additional for each mink skin involved, or by imprisonment
for not more than 90 days, or by both.' "
