AN ACT Relating to Membership in Advisory Committee of Highway Safety and Change of Name of Executive Secretary.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 23, § 104, amended. The first sentence of section 104 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The heads of the following state departments and agencies or their designated representatives shall constitute an Advisory Committee of State Officials: Attorney General, Secretary of State, Education, Highway Commission, State Police, Public Utilities Commission, **Commissioner of Health and Welfare, Commissioner of Labor and Industry.**

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 23, § 105, amended. Section 105 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 105. Executive director

The Governor shall appoint a person nominated by the executive board to be executive ~~secretary~~ **director** for a term of 4 years and fix his salary.
