AN ACT Relating to Automobile Mileage Allowage for State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 8, amended. The first sentence of section 8 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The State shall pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the State in the business of the State not more than 9c per mile ~~for the first 5,000 miles actually travelled by such employees on such business in any one fiscal year, and 7c for each mile exceeding 5,000 miles, except that the State shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes or table stock potatoes 9c for every mile so travelled.~~

Statement of Facts

It is estimated that this Act will cost about \$125,000 for a full fiscal year.
