### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Repealing the Law Requiring Assessment of Municipalities in Aid to Dependent Children Grants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 3750, repealed. Section 3750 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 468 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed.

#### Statement of Facts

It is estimated that this Act will cost about \$900,000 per year.
