HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 46, L.D. 36, Resolve, Designating
Certain Portions of the Interstate System at Kittery as
"The Piscataqua River Bridge."

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the last 2
paragraphs (same in L. D. 36) and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'Resolves, 1959, c. 54, amended.

Resolved: That chapter 54 of the resolves of 1959, as
last amended by chapters 27 and 31 of the resolves of 1965, is
further amended to read as follows:

Designation of Interstate Highway System. Resolved: That
in recognition of the outstanding and unselfish service rendered
by the late Brian M. Jewett to the State of Maine that the
Interstate Highway System in Maine, except for the bridges across
the Kennebec River from Fairfield to Benton and except for the
bridges from Stillwater to Houlton and except for the Maine Turn-
pike from the Kittery Entrance to the Gardiner Interchange and
the bridge across the Piscataqua River from Kittery to Portsmouth,
New Hampshire, be named the "Brian M. Jewett Memorial Highway"
and that appropriate plaques designating the name of the highway
be erected and maintained by the State Highway Commission at such
locations in rest areas as the State Highway Commission shall
select.'
