HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 47, L.D. 37, Bill, "An Act
Repealing Bounty on Bobcat and Canada Lynx."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'An Act Providing
for Bounty on Bobcat and Canada Lynx in Only Washington County.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following (same
in L.D. 37):

'R. S., T. 12, §2901, amended. The first sentence of section
2901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended
to read as follows:

There shall be a bounty of \$15 for every bobcat and Canada lynx
which is killed within ~~the State~~ Washington County, to be paid by
the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon
compliance with the following conditions.'
