HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 48, L.D. 38, Bill, "An Act Increasing Minimum Wages."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, §663, sub-§3, ¶L, additional.
Subsection 3 of section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph L to read as follows:

'L. Any individual employed by any retail or service establishment, except an establishment engaged in laundering, cleaning or repairing clothing or fabrics or an establishment engaged in the operation of a hospital, institution or school, if such establishment has an annual dollar volume of sales which is less than \$250,000, exclusive of excise taxes at the retail level which are separately stated. A retail or service establishment shall mean an establishment 75% of whose annual dollar volume of sales of goods or services, or of both, is not for resale and is recognized as retail sales or services in the particular industry.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
