STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Membership of State Soil and Water Conservation Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 51, amended. The first 2 sentences of Section 51 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 7 of chapter 190 of 'the public laws of 1965, are further amended to read as follows:

The State Soil and Water Conservation Committee, as heretofore established, shall serve as an agency of the State and shall perform the functions conferred upon it in this chapter. It shall consist of the following 7 10 members: The Dean of the College of Agriculture, the State Commissioner of Agriculture and, the State Forest Commissioner, State Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, State Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries, and the State Director of Parks and Recreation, who shall serve ex officiis; and 4 soil conservation district supervisors, one of which shall represent each of the following 4 areas: Area I, composed of the soil conservation districts of St. John Valley, Central Aroostook, Southern Aroostook and Washington County; Area 2, composed of the distircts of Piscataquis County, Somerset County, Franklin County and Kennebec County; Area 3, composed of the districts of Oxford County, Androscoggin Valley, Cumberland County and York County; Area 4, composed of Penobscot County, Waldo County, Knox-Lincoln and Hancock County.

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
