# RESOLVE, Relating to Repairing Training Vessel at Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute in South Portland.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 102nd Legislature appropriated funds for a training vessel at the Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute but due primarily to the Viet Nam conflict such a training vessel was unavailable; and

Whereas, the funds appropriated should be used to repair the present school training vessel which at the present time does not meet U.S. Coast Guard specifications: and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to provide the necessary training for the students attending the school; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Resolves, 1965, c. 77, amended. Resolved: That chapter 77 of the resolves of 1965 is amended to read as follows:

Appropriation for training vessel. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$50,000 to the Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 1968 to modify

a repair the present school training vessel to be acquired from government surplus as determined by the State Board of Education so that the specifications required by the U.S. Coast Guard may be met. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967 1969.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
