COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 33, L.D. 53, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Assistant County Attorneys."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence of that part designated "§553." of section 1 (same in L.D. 53).

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of the first paragraph of that part designated "§553." of section 1 (same in L.D. 53) and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'Assistants shall hold office during the term of the county attorney, or acting county attorney, by whom appointed, subject to removal at the pleasure of the county attorney or acting county attorney.'
