'Amend said Bill by striking out all of 18th 19th, and
20th lines of the Bill (17th, 18th and 19th in L.D. 57) and
inserting in place thereof the following:

In order to hold a municipal office, a person must be a resident
of the State and at least 21 years of age and, except in the
case of full-time appointed assessors, a citizen of the United
States.'
