AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Airport at Bar Harbor.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, tourism is one of Maine's most important industries; and

Whereas, the Bar Harbor area is one of Maine's most essential recreational areas; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to improve the Bar Harbor Airport soon enough to service the tourists coming into Maine in 1967; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bar Harbor Airport; funds for. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$120,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 to the Maine Aeronautics Commission for making necessary improvements, including extensions of runway and parking facilities, to the airport located at Bar Harbor (Bar Harbor Airport).

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
