STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Herbert Parsons of Gorham.

Howard Parsons; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$642.90, to be paid to Herbert Parsons of Gorham, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for destruction of his car by an escapee from the Men's Reformatory at Windham.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On May 5, 1966 an escapee of the Men's Reformatory took Mr. Parsons 1961 Chevrolet Wagon and damaged it to the extent of \$642.90.
