HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 57, L. D. 82, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Time for Voting on Local Option Questions
Under Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, §101, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 101 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Upon receipt of a petition of electors resident in that municipality in writing addressed to the Secretary of State and signed by at least 15% of the number of voters voting for the gubernatorial candidates at the last state-wide election in that municipality, which petition shall be filed with the Secretary of State on or before the first day of July April preceding the day of the biennial election, the ballots for that municipality shall carry in accordance with the petition any or all of the following additional questions: '
