IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Time for Voting on Local Option Questions Under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 101, amended. The first paragraph of section 101 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The aldermen of cities, the selectmen of towns and the assessors of plantations are empowered and directed to notify the inhabitants of their respective municipalities to meet, in the manner prescribed by law for the calling and holding of biennial meetings of said inhabitants for the election of Senators and Representatives, at the time of holding such biennial meeting primary elections to give in their votes upon the following questions:
