AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Rabbits in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2356, amended. The first paragraph of section 2356 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the first day of March to the 30th day of the following September, except in the Counties of Aroostook, Franklin, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Somerset ~~and Waldo and Washington~~, where there shall be a closed season from the first day of April to the 30th day of the following September. **There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits in the County of Washington from the first day of April to the 30th day of the following September and from the first day of November to the 5th day of December of each year.**
