AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Motor Vehicle Operator's License by Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2305, amended. The first sentence of section 2305 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

In addition to any other penalty provided in this Title and imposed by any court upon any person for violation of any provision of this Title, the court may suspend an operator's license for a period not exceeding ~~40 days~~ **6 months**, in which case the judge shall take up the license certificate of such person, who shall forthwith surrender the same and forward it by mail to the Secretary of State.
