STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing a Fire Chief for the Dover and Foxcroft Water District.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after the Legislature adjourns unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that a fire chief be appointed for the Dover-Foxcroft area to provide protection for the people in the area; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1863, c. 262, § 5, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 5 of chapter 262 of the private and special laws of 1863 is amended to read as follows:

Said water board shall have the full management and control of the water works system now owned by said corporation, and establish such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the convenient and proper management of said water works system, employ a superintendent, a **fire chief** and such other labor as may be necessary for the proper operation of said water works system, fix the amount of the water rentals which shall be uniform throughout said district, and do all things necessary for the proper operation of said system.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
