IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Marguerite Spohrer of York for Well Damage Resulting from Use of Salt on Route 1.

Marguerite Spohrer; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Marguerite Spohrer of York the sum of \$2,986 for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to her well as a result of the use of salt on Route I in York and the drainage which polluted said well.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Spohrer's well was completely damaged by salt because of drainage on Route I in York, 2 miles north of York Corner. The estimated damages are:
