AN ACT Relating to Permits to Operate Heavy Motor Vehicles in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1703, amended. The last paragraph of section 1703 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The State Highway Commission, in respect to state and state aid highways and bridges within city or compact village limits, and municipal officers in respect to all other ways and bridges within such city and compact village limits **and the county commissioners in respect to county roads and bridges located in unorganized territory in said county**, may grant permits to operate vehicles having a gross weight exceeding the limit of gross weight prescribed in this Title, and all such permits may contain any special conditions or provisions which in the opinion of the grantors are necessary.
