RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Cumberland County.

Fishing in certain waters in Cumberland County, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation extending the season to all fishing, except salmon, trout and togue, from September 30th to October 31st at Highland Lake in Bridgton, County of Cumberland.
