IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Examination of Vehicles by Police Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2121, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2121 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 21 of chapter 431 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to fail or refuse to stop ~~such~~ **any** vehicle, upon request or signal of any such officer.
