COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 107, L.D. 134, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Licensing and Regulation of Use of Explosives."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in place thereof the following Title:

'AN ACT Relating to Possession, Storage and Handling of Explosives.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 25, §2441, amended. The first paragraph of
section 2441 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to
read as follows:

The Insurance Commissioner shall make, amend or rescind,
after public hearing thereon, notice of which has been duly
advertised in the state paper, reasonable rules and regulations for
the keeping, possession, storage, handling, dispensing or trans-
porting from place to place in the State of all gunpowder, petroleum,
coal oils, burning fluids, naptha, benzine and all other explosives
and illuminating substances which such commissioner believes
dangerous to the lives or safety of citizens.'
