STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Construction and Assembling of Bombs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 502, amended. Section 502 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 502. Construction, assembling or possession

Whoever knowingly constructs, assembles, or has in his possession any device, bomb or infernal machine capable of being exploded or possesses materials appropriate for the construction thereof, except for lawful purposes, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 15 years, or by both.
