AN ACT Relating to the Construction and Assembling of Bombs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 502, amended. Section 502 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 502. Construction, assembling or possession

Whoever knowingly **constructs, assembles, or** has in his possession any **device,** bomb or infernal machine **capable of being exploded** or **possesses** materials appropriate for the construction thereof, except for lawful purposes, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 15 years, or by both.
