### **RESOLVE, Increasing Pension for Leeman Grant of Milbridge.**

---

**Leeman Grant; state pension increased. Resolved:** That a pension of \$100 per month is granted to Leeman Grant of Milbridge (formerly of Columbia Falls), to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1967 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of the resolves of 1943, chapter 59, which provided for a state pension for Leeman Grant, of Columbia Falls, is repealed.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Grant has received a pension from the State since May 1, 1943 in the amount of \$25. He finds it impossible to live on this amount of money.
