STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Specially Designed Motor Vehicle Number Plates for Indian Agents and Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 193, amended. The first sentence of section 193 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Secretary of State shall, upon application therefor by Maine members of the United States Senate, Maine members of the United States House of Representatives, members of the Executive Council, members of the Legislature, Representatives of the Indian Tribes at the Legislature, **the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, the Indian Agents,** President of the Senate, Speaker of the House, Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House, issue one pair of specially designed number plates and a certificate of registration for one designated motor vehicle owned or controlled by each of the officials named.
