### STATE OF MAINE

### AN ACT Relating to Use of Dealer Registration Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 331, amended. The 4th sentence of section 331 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Such certificate of registration shall contain the name, place of residence and business of the applicant and the general distinguishing number, color or mark assigned to him and made in such form as the Secretary of State may determine, and all vehicles owned or controlled by such applicant shall be regarded as registered under such general distinguishing number, color or mark until sold **or** exchanged or operated for hire.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 336, sub-§ 2, amended. The first sentence of subsection 2 of section 336 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A vehicle loaned by a dealer to a customer for demonstration or emergency purposes may be operated on the registration plates of the dealer for not more than 7 consecutive days and while a customer's car is being repaired, a dealer may charge a nominal service charge for the use of the motor vehicle.
