## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Audits for Judiciary and Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 243, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 243 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**I. Post-audit.** To perform a post-audit of all accounts and other financial records of the State Government or any department or agency thereof, **including the judiciary and the Legislature**, and to report annually on this audit, and at such other times as the Legislature may require;

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 1541, sub-§ 11, additional. Section 1541 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 11, to read as follows:

11. Definition. The words, "the State Government," as used in this section shall include the judiciary and the Legislature.
