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### **AN ACT Relating to Audits for Judiciary and Legislature.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 243, sub-§ I, amended.** Subsection 1 of section 243 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

**1. Post-audit.** To perform a post-audit of all accounts and other financial records of the State Government or any department or agency thereof, **including the judiciary and the Legislature**, and to report annually on this audit, and at such other times as the Legislature may require ;

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 154I, sub-§ II, additional.** Section 154I of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection II, to read as follows :

**II. Definition.** The words, "the State Government," as used in this section shall include the judiciary and the Legislature.
