### **AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Justices of Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 4, amended.** The first sentence of section 4 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of ~~\$18,000~~ \$21,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$19,000~~ \$22,000.

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 4, § 102, amended.** The first sentence of section 102 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$17,500~~ \$20,500.

**Sec. 3. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts the sum of \$36,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$48,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
