STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Justices of Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of Title 4 of the Revised Stautes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of \$18,000 \$21,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of \$19,000 \$22,000.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 4, § 102, amended. The first sentence of section 102 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of \$17,500 \$20,500.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts the sum of \$36,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$48,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
