SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 83, L. D. 164, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Licensing of Premises for Dancing Purposes."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§161" by
striking out all of the 5th underlined paragraph and inserting
in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

' A fee of \$10 shall be fixed by the Insurance Commissioner
for said license and said fee shall be credited to the Division
of Fire Prevention.'
