STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Creating a Regional Coordination Program Under the Division of Industrial Promotion of the Department of Economic Development.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 10, § 501, sub-§ 9, additional. Section 501 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 9, to read as follows:
- Regional coordination. Adopt a system of regional coordination utilizing 5 regional coordinators employed contractually by the director exclusive of Title 5, part 2, and assigned to one of 5 regions covering the State while maintaining facilities within the division in order to assist the director in performance of the duties of this subchapter.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Economic Development the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

(It is the intent of the Legislature that the sum of \$50,000 be used for contractual services each year and the sum of \$10,000 be used for travel expenses, etc.)
