COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 109, L. D. 180, Bill, "An Act Relating to Licensing of Elevator Mechanics."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th (same in L. D. 180) underlined lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'No person shall service, repair, alter or install any elevator unless he is licensed as an elevator mechanic under section 440. Elevator work in industrial plants, manufacturing plants and hospitals may be performed by plant personnel who are not licensed under sections 439 to 441, provided such work is supervised by the plant engineer.'
