#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Definition of Hotel under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 2, sub-§ 9, amended. Subsection 9 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by sections 1 and 2 of chapter 404 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding after the 4th sentence, a new sentence to read as follows:

In the case of both full-time and part-time licenses at least 10% of the gross income of each hotel shall be derived from rental of rooms.
