SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 89, L. D. 186, Bill, "An Act Relating to Compensation and Allowances for Members of the Indian Tribes at the Legislature."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The member of the Penobscot Indian Tribe and the member of the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe elected by-~~it~~ to represent the his tribe at the biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive a compensation of \$500 \$1,000 for such attendance, with the same allowances for travel, meals and housing as any other member of the Senate and House of Representatives.'
