

## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 103rd LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 89, L. D. 186, Bill, "An Act Relating to Compensation and Allowances for Members of the Indian Tribes at the Legislature."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The member of the <u>Penobscot</u> Indian Tribe <u>and the member</u> of the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe elected by-it to represent the <u>his</u> tribe at the biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive a compensation of \$500 <u>\$1,000</u> for such attendance, with the same allowances for travel, meals and housing as any other member of the Senate and House of Representatives.'
