SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 89, L. D. 186, Bill, "An Act Relating to Compensation and Allowances for Members of the Indian Tribes at the Legislature."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph and inserting in place there of the following:

'The member of the <u>Penobscot</u> Indian Tribe <u>and the member of</u> <u>the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe</u> elected by-it to represent the <u>his</u> tribe at the biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive a compensation of \$500 for such attendance <u>and travel at</u> <u>each legislative session for 20 trips to and from his place of</u> <u>abode at the same rate as state employees receive, and allowance</u> for meals and housing expenses as any other member of the Senate <u>and House of Representatives for 20 days' attendance at each</u> <u>legislative session.</u>'
