AN ACT Relating to Compensation and Allowances for Members of the Indian Tribes at the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 3, § 2 amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 342 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

The member of the **Penobscot Indian Tribe** and the member of the **Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe** elected ~~by it~~ to represent ~~the~~ his tribe at the biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive ~~a compensation of \$500 for such attendance~~ the same compensation, mileage and allowance as any other member of the Senate and House of Representatives.
