HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 117, L.D. 188, Bill, "An Act Relating to Rights and Privileges of Members of the Indian Tribes at the Legislature."

Amend said Bill in the 4th and 5th lines (4th line in L.D. 188) by striking out the underlined words "With the exception of the right to vote on pending legislation, the" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word "The"

Further amend said Bill by striking out the period at the end (same in L.D. 188) and inserting in place thereof the following: ',except that he shall have the right to speak only on all legislation affecting Maine Tribal Indians.'
