AN ACT Permitting Town of Newcastle to Pay Certain Out-of-State Tuition.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of Newcastle permitted to pay certain out-of-state tuition. The Town of Newcastle, Lincoln County, is authorized to reimburse Robert H. Page of Damariscotta for tuition paid by him during the school year 1966-67 for his daughter's attendance at the American Community School in Beirut, Lebanon, at the same rate as the Town of Newcastle would have paid Lincoln Academy if enrollment as a student had been in Lincoln Academy for the school year 1966-1967.
