AN ACT Permitting Advance Baiting for Taking Whitefish from Sebago Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2756, amended. Section 2756 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

This section shall not apply to "advance baiting" on Sebago Lake for the taking of whitefish by hook and line.
